BOURGOGNE

whites are esteemed for their terroir-driven Chardonnay. Typically, Bourgogne Blanc, Chablis and Mâconnais are unoaked with whites from within the Côte de Beaune usually oak-aged. Aligoté is the less famous white grape from Bourgogne. The best examples are dry with high acid, floral and herbaceous with lemon fruit.
